Location of the Formentor Lighthouse

The Formentor Lighthouse is located in the far north of the Serra de Tramuntana, an area with a surface of 90 square kilometres. The Formentor peninsula is in the municipality of Pollença, 54 Km away from the capital city of the Balearic Islands, Palma.

Information on the travel restrictions

There will be traffic restrictions in the Formentor Lighthouse during summer in order to preserve and protect the great landscape and natural heritage of the Serra de Tramuntana, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It concerns us all.

For this reason traffic is restricted from 1st June to 30th September 2023, from 10:00 to 22:30.

Who has access?



- Public transport managed by the Government of the Balearic Islands (TIB) for both sections of road.



- Discretionary transport, taxis and TNCs for the Formentor-Beach section.



- Residents of the section where the restrictions apply and vehicles transporting people with reduced mobility (authorisation must be requested at least three days in advance).



- Service, rescue, medical, emergency and security force vehicles.



- Bikes and walkers.

Information on public transport lines

Using public transport to travel to the Formentor peninsula is recommended. The TIB has a bus line:

- 334: Alcúdia - Port de Pollença - Formentor Lighthouse.

On the Formentor Peninsula, the line stops at the Mirador del Colomer, Formentor Beach, Cala Figuera-Cala Murta and Formentor Lighthouse.

Avoid the use of cash on buses, we recommend using credit cards or transport cards and checking updated timetables, prices and the route of each bus line at **www.tib.org**.

Where to park

Line 334 connects with other TIB bus lines at the stop in Port de Pollença and at the stop in the historical center of Alcúdia, allowing people to do full journeys by bus from other places in Mallorca without the need to use a car.

For those arriving at the Port of Pollença by car, we recommend parking in the service lanes on the ring road, where parking is free of charge. There are three stops on the ring road where travellers can get the bus towards the Formentor peninsula: Port of Pollença (42051), Bóquer (42057) and Can Singala (42055).




Requesting authorisation for each of the two sections

Residents of the section where the restrictions apply, vehicles that transport people with reduced mobility and anyone else who may be authorised have to contact the DGT at least three working days in advance via the email address formentor@dgt.es.

Formentor Lighthouse km 8.7 to 19.6: circulation prohibited in both directions during the times in which the restrictions apply. If you enter the travel restricted area before 10:00, you must leave the area before 9:59.

Fines will be issued to vehicles that travel in the area without authorisation.

Formentor Beach km 2 to 8.7: limited access until full capacity of authorised parking spaces.
